



# Rules & Regulations



1. Any dog may be assessed by the Hunt Master, Lure Operator, Paddock or Field Master at any time. All new dogs will be assessed prior to their first run for body condition, lameness, temperament, and physiological limitations.
2. Any dog not found “fit to run” for any of the above conditions will not be allowed to course that day.
3. No dog(s) may enter the course while another dog(s) are in the start or are running the course.
4. All dogs must be either crated or on a held leash. No retractable or bungee leashes are allowed while on the coursing field or in galley.
5. Suggested collars are martingale or hound collars (no choke, slip or prong collars) for dogs with small or narrow heads, i.e. whippets, greyhounds.
6. Harness are also a good way to be certain that dogs will not slip out of their collar and join the “hunt”.
7. Owners and/or spectators are not allowed on the coursing field unless authorized by the Hunt Master, Lure Operator, Paddock, or Field Master.
8. No owners or spectators may change the course at any time without the direct authorization of the Hunt Master/Lure Operator.
9. Dogs will run in order as determined by the Paddock Master.
10. Dog treats/food and water will be limited to small amounts to avoid stomach upset and injury. No treats will be given to any dog without the consent of its owner.
